# Regulations General rules

### Who is concerned by TRIMAN signage?

All producers, importers, and distributors of their own brand products intended for household use who are subject to an extended producer responsibility (EPR) provision.

#### ■ Where must it be affixed?

This signage consists of the TRIMAN logo and information on procedures for sorting or transferring waste resulting from the product, and must be provided in close proximity to the product:

- on the product
- on the product's packaging
- or in other documentation provided with the product

Provision of information on the website remains possible, but does not replace inclusion on one of the three items mentioned above.

If the various components of the product are subject to different sorting procedures, these procedures shall be detailed for each of the components.

#### ■ When must it be done?

Affixing the TRIMAN logo on all products subject to extended producer responsibility (EPR) has been a regulatory requirement since 1 January 2015. The implementation procedures were modified in 2020 by the French Anti-Waste Act for a Circular Economy.

Each sector concerned by EPR has its own implementation deadlines, detailed in the following chapters.



Article L. 541-9-3 of the French **Environmental Code stipulates that** any product placed on the market for household use, excluding household glass packaging for drinks, must include signage to inform the consumer that this product is subject to sorting regulations.

Article L. 541-9-4 of the French **Environmental Code provides for an** administrative fine of up to €15,000 for a legal entity in the absence of sorting signage (...).

The competent supervisory authority is the French Directorate General for Consumer Affairs, Competition, and Fraud Prevention (DGCCRF). A fine may therefore be applied by DGCCRF inspectors for each product that does not have TRIMAN signage and information on sorting procedures. However, the fine amounts stated in the French Environmental Code are maximum amounts.

#### Decree no. 2014-1577 of 23 December 2014

on signage common to recyclable products subject to sorting requirements

#### Act no. 2020-105 of 10 February 2020

on combating waste and on the circular economy: Article 17

#### Decree no. 2021-835 of 29 June 2021

on consumer information regarding the rules for sorting waste resulting from products subject to the principle of extended producer responsibility

#### Decree no. 2022-975 of 1 July 2022

on the inclusion of decorative textile items covered by the extended producer responsibility approach for furniture items, and amending various provisions relating to waste

The procedures for applying sorting signage for decorative textile items will be communicated once the producer responsibility organisations are approved.

### Exceptions

However, there are exceptions regarding the display of the TRIMAN logo and sorting information:

- ▶ If the surface area of the largest side of a product or its packaging is between 10 and 20 cm²: the sorting information can be dematerialised, but affixing of the TRIMAN logo remains mandatory.
- If the surface area of the largest side of a product or its packaging is less than 10 cm²: the TRIMAN instructions and the sorting information can be entirely dematerialised.



For cylindrical or spherical products or packaging, these surface areas of 10 and 20 cm<sup>2</sup> are increased to 20 and 40 cm<sup>2</sup>.



# Regulations Implementation timeline

- Stages of implementation of TRIMAN signage, common to all sectors:
- ▶ Presentation of proposals to partners and public authorities
- **▶ Validation of signage** by public authorities
- **Entry into force** of affixing procedures
- **▶ Deadline for affixing procedures :** 12 months
- 6-month stock disposal deadline, after the end of the implementation period. Deadline valid only for certain sectors



Since January 2023, distributors of DIY and gardening products and toys (whether individuals or legal entities) subject to the extended responsibility of the marketer have been bound by the obligation of recovery, during physical or distance selling.

This obligation has existed since January 2022 for furniture items and for decorative textile items since January 2023.



# Sorting signage The TRIMAN logo

### Regulatory context

**The TRIMAN logo** is a visual identifier for all products subject to extended producer responsibility (EPR).

As one of the commitments of the Grenelle environmental charter, the TRIMAN logo entered into force on 1 January 2015, following publication of the Decree of 23 December 2014 establishing signage common to all products subject to sorting requirements.

This sorting signage is intended to simplify the sorting process for consumers and to help improve collection and recycling rates.

### Symbols composing the TRIMAN logo

All TRIMAN signage is composed of three graphic elements, which are **strictly inseparable**:



A circular arrow around the silhouette, symbolising recycling

#### Three arrows,

symbolising sorting, to enable better waste processing



#### Methodology

Ecomaison conducted a consumer survey in September 2021 to understand consumer perception of the second life of used items.

The conclusions of this survey, organised by Harris Interactive, were taken into account when writing the message and instructions.

# Sorting signage Message and instructions



Two messages were selected with reference to the second life of products: donating and recycling.

▶ Donating, to promote product sustainability.

Whether passed on to family or friends or donated to a charity, used items can have a second life.

Ecomaison is a partner of over 400 social and charitable associations, which resell collected items at an affordable price.

#### **▶** Recycling, to encourage zero waste.

Messages

Recycling used objects involves transforming their constituent materials into various new recycled raw materials.

#### Instructions

The sorting instructions are intended to inform consumers of all possible solutions for giving used items a second life.

The order in which the three outcomes are presented is designed to encourage donations as much as possible, and therefore reuse of the product:

- **▶ Donations** to social and charitable associations
- ▶ Drop-off at textile containers, dedicated to curtains and nets
- ▶ Recovery in-store or upon delivery, depending on certain conditions of store size or turnover
- **▶** Drop-off at a waste disposal centre

### Protected area

This is defined in relation to the size of the "FR" bubble. It marks out a space around the TRIMAN symbol and the logo block within which no graphic element (text, rule, image) should appear.

### It is prohibited to

- Change the colour of the TRIMAN. It must remain the same colour as the logo block.
- 2) Use the signage without the TRIMAN logo.
- Ohange the position of the TRIMAN.
- Change the size of the TRIMAN.
- 5 Change the proportions of the signage.

If the signage is placed on a coloured background, reverse printing must be used.



As the texts are not intended to be modified, the font has been vectorised for optimal use of the graphic elements.

Native files are available in the kit provided by Ecomaison. This includes horizontal and vertical versions in three colours in Illustrator, PDF, and PNG formats.

The compact version should only be used when space is limited. This version may not be reduced under any circumstances.

The ratio between the different elements of which the signage is composed must be respected in the event of enlargement.






## Packaging labels

For this type of medium, we recommend using the black monochrome version.



### **■** Instruction manuals

For assembly instructions, we recommend using the black monochrome version due to printing constraints for this type of format.






The information may be provided on invoices, quotes, catalogues, and online, but this cannot replace its mandatory inclusion on the product, its packaging, or on other documentation supplied with the product.

#### Quotes

For quotes, purchase orders, and invoices, we recommend use of the monochrome version due to printing constraints for this type of format.



### Catalogues

For catalogues, we recommend using the black monochrome version, at the bottom of the page, indicating the mandatory information.






The information may be provided on invoices, quotes, catalogues, and online, but this cannot replace its mandatory inclusion on the product, its packaging, or on other documentation supplied with the product.

# This signage is chosen at the discretion of the marketer. If you sell furniture exclusively, choose the version dedicated to furniture specialists. For other products such as bedding, please opt for the signage dedicated to nonspecialists.

Both versions are equivalent, and affixing them in close proximity to the product will ensure regulatory compliance.

Both versions are equivalent, and affixing them in close proximity to the product will ensure regulatory compliance.

According to the typology of products, you can choose for one of the following options:

- Version dedicated to curtains and nets with 4 pictograms, mentioning the inflow in textile containers.
- Version for generalists, for all other products in the decorative textiles category.



  upon delivery, or drop-off at
  a waste disposal centre
- A version with four pictograms also mentioning in-store donation.
















# **FAQ**

# What are the specific requirements for products sold internationally?

The compulsory display of sorting signage only applies to products intended for the French market. For this reason, sorting signage is accompanied by an indication of the country concerned: "FR". Each Member State of the European Union applies its own sorting guidelines within its territory, since these depend on the reuse and recycling capacities of each State.

However, it should be noted that, for products imported from another European country, sorting signage may be replaced by equivalent signage recognised by the European Union or a Member State.

# What are the obligations of marketplaces?

The marketplace is deemed responsible, in lieu of the third-party sellers who use its platform, and is required to provide or contribute to waste prevention and management, in accordance with the provisions of Articles L. 541-10 (EPR obligation).

As such, it is subject to the obligation of sorting signage for its products. If the third-party seller does not fulfil its obligation to display sorting signage,

the marketplace must fulfil this obligation in lieu of the third-party seller.



# **FAQ**

# Can the colour of the sorting signage be changed?

Ecomaison does not require you to use one of the versions in the proposed colours of black or green.

If you wish to place the logo on a coloured background, we recommend using the version with a white border, as in the example below:

The regulatory obligation relates to the visibility of the logo, which must be affixed in close proximity to the product.



# Must the sorting information be durable?

The marketer's obligation to display information relates to the visibility of this information to consumers. The

law has not specified the procedures for affixing the information.

The signage may be affixed in numerous ways, including:

- ▶ by adding signage on the product,
- ▶ by adding the TRIMAN signage to the relevant documents,
- ▶ by affixing a sticker onto the product itself, its packaging, or its documentation.

By way of reminder, the sorting signage must be provided in close proximity to the product:

- on the product,
- on the product's packaging,
- or in other documentation provided with the product.



# FAQ

## Is affixing on auxiliary documents compulsory?

The TRIMAN signage and information on sorting procedures may be affixed to all documents supplied with the product at the time of sale, such as the service manual or the user guide.

Digital versions are not subject to this obligation, but Ecomaison strongly recommends that you do so, to promote consumer awareness of sorting instructions.

# Can the size of the TRIMAN signage be reduced?

The dimensions indicated in this guide are recommendations. You may therefore change the size of the signage. However, please note that the regulations relate to the visibility of the message intended for your customers. The law requires the TRIMAN to remain sufficiently visible to inform customers.

The ratio between the different elements of which the signage is composed must be respected in the event that the size of the sorting signage is changed.



# **FAQ**

# ■ Which sorting instructions should I use for furniture?

# The choice of the variation of the signage is at the discretion of the marketer:

- ▶ For furniture, preferably choose the version dedicated to furniture specialists, specifically mentioning furniture in the message.
- ▶ For curtains and nets, please use the dedicated signage. In fact, these products can be collected with the clothes, in dedicated textile containers.
- ▶ For other products such as bedding, storage boxes, rugs and all their accessories, please opt for the marking dedicated to generalists.

The three versions are equivalent and their affixing as close as possible to the product makes it possible to meet the regulatory obligation.
